The Grand Opening of the Eagle's Nest Basic Needs Center on the Lake county Campus of Woodland Community College is scheduled for August 31, 2021. The Eagles' Nest is a one-stop shop to provide students with resources to help meet their basic needs such as food, housing and school supplies. In addition the Center includes a "community office" where representatives from social service agencies, will assist students in signing up for CalFresh and MediCal, accessing mental health services and applying for housing programs.

The goal of the center is to provide students with the essential resources required to thrive while attending LCC.
